

Exam 1 Correction

4 questions on the first exam were graded with the wrong answer (Questions 23-26). In computing your grade for the exam, I will add 4 points to your previous score and that will form the basis for your new score on the multiple choice component of the exam.

The "Letter Grade Equivalent" for the multiple choice part of the exam I announced after the last exam:

A	A-	B+	B	B-	C+	C	C-	D+	D
24.40271	21.61133	18.81995	16.02857	13.23719	10.44581	7.654429	4.863048	2.071667	1.5

Is still operative.

For example, if you scored a 13 on the multiple choice part of Exam 1 (which corresponds to a B-), your score is now 17, which means your grade on the multiple choice component of Exam 1 now corresponds to a B.
